NUAGA

New Ulm Area Gymnastics Academy is a dynamic, growing, non-profit organization providing recreational and competitive opportunities for children of all ages. NUAGA began in 1998 with the goal of providing quality gymnastics instruction in a safe, exciting, active environment. That philosophy still holds true today. Our Program director Cheryl MacFarlane has 19 years gymnastics experience, and a love for working with children. She is USAG safety, CPR and First-aid certified; she also has KAT (Kinder accreditation for teachers) training. All the coaches at NUAGA provide instruction on all apparatus with emphasis on body awareness, strength, flexibility, skill development and SAFETY!!

Class Descriptions

- **Preschool** classes are designed for children who are kindergarten age and younger. Children learn basic gymnastics skills and terminology in an age appropriate manner. Children will experience vault, bars, beam, floor and trampoline along with fun coordination building games.
- **Girls Progressive** classes are designed for school age girls. From beginner to advanced. Girls will learn skills on all womens apparatus and trampoline.
- **Boys** classes are designed for school age boys. They will learn skills on all mens apparatus and trampoline. This class will work on individual skill level.
- **Open Gym** This is an opportunity to experience the gym on your own. A coach will be available to supervise and answer questions.

Annual Insurance

All students attending class at NUAGA must pay insurance as follows.
September 1 –August 31. Ages 6 + years \$25, ages 5 and under \$15.

Family Discount

For families with multiple students, we offer a 20% discount on class fees for the second and subsequent children.

Refer a friend

Tell your friends about NUAGA. For each new student that signs up for class and puts your name in the “referred by” space, you will receive **10%** off your next session tuition. Limit five referrals per session.

Scholarships

United Way of Brown County provides scholarships to young people from the age of 4 to 18. They are available up to \$250 per year (August to July), per youth and /or 90% of the activity fees.

Fundraising/Volunteer Hours

Each family is required to participate in only two fundraisers. Randy’s Good Stuff which is conducted in Fall and either purchase 10 Raffle or 7 Taco Fiesta Tickets. Each family is also required to volunteer five hours for the year. These hours can be put in during concessions for High School/Team meets, Taco Fiesta, Promotional events such as ECFE Fun Fair, Brown County Fair, and Parades or tasks requested by the director.
